Hair Options for Spring Showcase

At SASD we believe in letting our dancers be individuals on and off the stage. Therefore we do not set a specific hair style, as many hair types, lengths and thicknesses differ. Below are various options, some more easy and basic than others, that would all be acceptable for showcase weekend.

Dancers with hair that goes past their ears, must have braids or a bun that keeps their hair off the floor, especially in our acrobatics routines. If your dancer arrives to Wamogo with their hair down, or in a long ponytail, a backstage mom will put it into a bun for safety reasons.

Dancers with shorter hair that are not in acrobatics numbers are more than welcome to utilize some sort of pony tail style updo- seen below with curls.

One thing all of these hair options below utilize are commonly found products, listed below.

- Hair spray &/or gel, which keeps hair secure, and free of whispies!
- Bobby pins/hair pins, to keep buns secure and from falling out mid showcase, in the color of your dancers hair. Pins also keep headpieces for any given routine from falling off.
 - Hair ties that are the color of your dancers hair.
- Hair nets- seen in the bottom right image, which are used to wrap around buns and keep all hair in place!
