Sparkle & Shine Dance Makeup Info For Spring Showcase

We want all of our dancers and their families to be comfortable with the amount of makeup their dancer is wearing on stage during showcase weekend!

Makeup is a wonderful tool, used to keep your dancers features looking bright and sparkly when on a big stage with bright lights. Often, without makeup, your dancer will look washed out, keep this in mind when you're hoping to snap a picture of their big smile on stage!

There are some basic guidelines below, that we use to help guide our dance families in the right direction when making decisions about makeup.

Please make sure to send a small baggy or makeup bag, clearly labeled with your dancers name, with any extra makeup they may need backstage in order to freshen up before they step on stage. An assistants or trust backstage mother will help all dancers in this process to avoid any mishaps!

Basic Dancer Makeup Shopping List:

- Foundation, in the shade of your dancers skin
- Blush, light red or pink
- Lipstick, red or pink
- Eye shadow, in natural tones (browns, tans, silvers, golds)- NEVER orange, purple, blue or green as these do not look good under the stage lights
- Mascara
